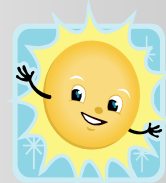

Subject:	High School Transportation information for 2025/26

Chinook School Division provides bus service to Swift Current Comprehensive High School students who live in the following areas: south side, Jenmar/Ponderosa area, Sask Valley area and the Highland/Trail areas.

If you reside in these areas, you can purchase a bus pass at student services when school begins. Students can ride without showing proof of purchase for the first two weeks of each semester. The **cost** of a bus pass for 2025/26 school year is **\$200/semester**. To view the SCCHS walk zone click [SCCHS walk Zone](#)
